## Stefan 'Steve' Dwojak

Stefan "Steve" Dwojak, 81, died at 3:01 a.m. Wednesday, Oct. 7, 2009 in Marion General Hospital.

Steve was a member of St. Mary's Ukrainian Church in Venice, Florida and attended St. Paul Catholic Church in Marion. He enjoyed spending time with friends and especially visiting over coffee at Bob Evans.
